NOTICE TO FOREST STAKEHOLDERS

Please be advised that all harvesting permits issued under Haliburton County Forestry Conservation By-Law 3196 expire on March 31st annually. If you intend to continue harvesting, a new permit application with landowner signature is required.

For your information, the new Endangered Species Act is now in effect. Lands where permits are requested are checked with the MNR's Species at Risk database. Permits may include recommendations (such as winter harvest only) that will help the applicants to avoid potential impacts to threatened and endangered species.

Please remember to phone the by-law officer within 24 hours of the commencement of harvesting on a permit area, or upon resuming operations after any 4 week period of inactivity. It is an offence not to do so.
